Use your hat press

Before first use, heat press will be in activation mode, download Cricut Heat™ app to activate.

Once connected, send precise settings & get step-by-step instructions for every project from your mobile device.

How to use Cricut® Hat Pressing Form

1 Unfasten hat and remove its insert



4 Tightly fasten hat around form

2 Fold down sweatband, use both hands to place hat over form



5 Ensure pressing surface is flat and firm

3 Use handle to adjust form inside hat until snug



6 Follow instructions in Cricut Heat™ app

How to operate

- Plug into compatible wall outlet
- Press **Power Button (3)** to turn on
- To cycle to desired heat setting, press **Temperature Button (3)**
- To start timer, press **Go Button (2)**
- To power off, press **Power Button (3)** to cycle through heat settings, or press and hold until audible beep
- Auto-off after 13 minutes of inactivity

products with a form factor dedicated to heat transfers on hats, namely caps. Controlling the Cricut Hat Press is simple using either the built-in controls or Bluetooth® technology. Three simple heat settings take on every possible heat transfer project, including permanent Infusible Ink™ transfers that become one with the base material. With an extra layer of protection on its ceramic-coated heat plate, Cricut Hat Press effortlessly glides over oddly shaped surfaces to transfer your design. Safety features include an insulated safety base and an auto-shutoff feature. It's lightweight, portable, easy to store, and compatible with major brands of iron-on/HTV, Infusible Ink & sublimation products.
